




The company is located in the heart of the province of Varese, 40 kilometres from Milan and a few minutes away from Malpensa international airport.



Energy efficiency is an equally crucial issue in terms of production processes, thanks to the use of latest generation looms, and levels of energy consumption.

As a result of these concerns, we were granted the *OEKO-TEX® STANDARD*100 certification for our collections.

Furthermore, through our line made in organic cotton, we have also earned *GOTS*,

while *GRS* recognizes our recycled items. We are also a member of *BCI*, the Better Cotton Initiative, ratifying that it is not fine words, but hard facts that make the difference towards better future.





### OEKO-TEX®




This certification is an independent and uniform international control system for *raw materials*, semi-finished and finished products. It is used in the textile sector at all levels of processing, and can also be applied for accessory materials, allowing those products that *do not present any risk to the health* of the consumer to be identified.

OEKO-TEX® toxic substances controls are mainly designed considering the intended use of the fabrics and materials. The more intense the contact of a product with the skin and the more sensitive the latter is, the stricter the *human-ecological requirements* must be.

The use of natural organic fibers, process tracking throughout the production chain and the adoption on *sustainable procedures* has led to the formalization of the *GOTS* international standard.

It allows the production and promotion of environmentally friendly textile products and workers' fundamental social rights.

#### GLOBAL RECYCLE STANDARD CERTIFICATION

The *GRS* certifies products obtained from *recycled materials* and manufacturing processes.

It promotes products made with recycled materials, in compliance with environmental and social criteria, which extend to all stages of our production chain.


